AffloVest requires a doctor's prescription for treatment by high frequency chest wall oscillation (HFCWO). AffloVest has received the FDA's 510k clearance for U.S. market availability, and is approved for Medicare, Medicaid, and private health insurance reimbursement under the Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) code E0483 – High Frequency Chest Wall Oscillation. AffloVest is also available through the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs/Tricare. Patients must qualify to meet insurance eligibility requirements.

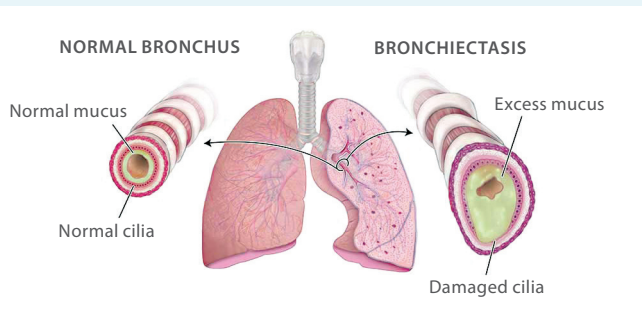

Bronchiectasis (pronounced bron-kee-eck-tuh-sis) is a chronic condition that occurs when the walls of the lung's airways thicken from chronic inflammation or infection. Mucus builds up and inflammation makes it difficult for lungs to clear and to expel mucus. If airways can't clear, bacteria grows, leading to repeated and serious lung infections and breathing impairment.



Bronchiectasis is often confused with COPD and asthma. It requires different therapy.

If your symptoms aren't improving with current treatments, it's important to talk to your doctor. A CT scan can help determine if bronchiectasis is the cause. While there's no cure, early diagnosis and treatment can help prevent further lung damage and improve your quality of life.²

What are the signs of bronchiectasis?

- Do you have COPD or another chronic lung disease?
- Have you had a daily productive (mucus) cough for the past six months?
- Do you have frequent coughing episodes with mucus that is thick, yellow, green or discolored?
- Have you been on two or more courses of antibiotics for a lung infection or bronchitis in the past 12 months?
- Have you been hospitalized for a respiratory or lung infection in the past 12 months?

If you answered YES to any of these questions, talk to your doctor about bronchiectasis today.
